
At The Market. What you need to know

Don't forget that single-use plastics are banned in ACT, so you can't bring them to the market. Since July 2021, you can no longer have

degradable plastic products that contain additives, such as plastic bags. Instead, you should use paper bags when required. You can read more about the single-use plastics ban in the Market <u>Information section of the Members' Resource Area</u> (scroll down towards the bottom of the page). **Selling Out of Your Products** If you sell out before we close, yay for you! 🥳 Remember to pop a sold out sign on your stall before you go for a wander. We know it might

be tempting to pack up early and go home, but please don't. You can't pack up until closing time at 4:00 pm (nope, not even at 3:45 pm). No Smoking Please don't smoke or vape inside the venue. Enough said.

Please remember that all food vendors will be in the Cooroong

Pavilion. No matter the weather, the fans are always on, so please bring layers as it can get cold under the fans. **Rubbish During The Market**

Did you know we have three HUGE skip bins outside the Coorong Pavilion for you to put all your rubbish in? Well, now you do. So please use these bins for all your rubbish (including during bump-out) rather than using the bins inside. Either take your rubbish to the skip bins or take it home.
